



Reduce the spread of infection in long-distance public transport by bus or train

According to the temporary COVID-19 Act, businesses have a duty to prevent the spread of infection by operating in such a way that crowding of people is avoided and ensuring that people can keep a safe distance from each other from an epidemiological point of view.

If you run or organise public transport by bus or train with a route exceeding 150 kilometres, you must:

- Take appropriate measures to prevent the spread of infection.
- Conduct the business so that crowding of people is avoided and that people can keep a safe distance from each other from an epidemiological point of view.
- Limit the number of passengers on such journeys so that, at any time or in any space, they do not exceed half of the number of seats in the train/bus.

The provisions do not apply to trips booked before the restrictions entered into force on 14 February 2021. The restrictions apply until 31 May 2021.
