



## Reduce the spread of infection at public gatherings and public events

According to the temporary COVID-19 Act, businesses have a duty to prevent the spread of infection by operating in such a way that crowding of people is avoided and ensuring that people can keep a safe distance from each other from an epidemiological point of view.

### If you are organising a public gathering or public event, you must:

- Limit the number of participants to a maximum of 8 participants.
- Limit the number of participants in a public gathering held for religious practice in connection with death to a maximum of 20 participants.
- The County Administrative Boards may make further restrictions on the number of participants. All counties have done so, and accordingly there is a limit of no more than 8 participants for events with a seated audience.
